Executive Summary:

To receive funds for instructional materials from the State, governing boards of school districts are subject to the requirements of Educational Code 60119, which states that the districts are required to hold a public hearing to adopt a resolution declaring whether each pupil in the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks that have been adopted by the State Board of Education. To comply with the Williams Lawsuit settlement, new regulations require that instructional materials align with the state content standards.

REGARDING SUFFICIENCY OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

Whereas, the Board of Trustees of the Goleta Union School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119 held a public hearing on September 5, 2018, at 7:00 p.m., which is on or before the eighth week of school and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

Whereas, the Board of Trustees provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

Whereas, the Board of Trustees encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing, and;

Whereas, information provided at the public hearing and to the Board of Trustees at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the district, and;

Whereas, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and;

Whereas, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners, that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects:

- Mathematics
 - Bridges (K-5, The Math Learning Center, Adopted 2015)
 - Core Connections I (Grade 6, College Preparatory Math, Adopted 2015)
- Science
 - Full Option Science System (K-5, Delta Education, Adopted 2008)
 - Holt California Science: Earth Science (Holt, Rinehart, and Winston, Adopted 2008)
- History-social science
 - Reflections (K-6, Harcourt School Publishers, Adopted 2007)
- English/language arts, including English language development components
 - Open Court Reading (K-3, SRA/McGraw-Hill, Adopted 2002)
 - Houghton-Mifflin Reading (4-6, Houghton-Mifflin, Adopted 2002) and;

Therefore, it is resolved that for the 2018-2019 school year, the Goleta Union School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
