**1. Welcome and Introductions**

Dr. Lewis opened the meeting at 8:50 a.m. She reviewed the topics to be covered at today's meeting.

**2. Approval of the Minutes from January 24, 2019**

**3. School Presentation – Dr. Joanna Lauer, Principal of Mountain View School**

Dr. Lauer shared that three highlights of the school are: academic programming, positive behavior supports and community building. She stated that at Mountain View they believe that all students should have the opportunity for challenge at every level, behavior should be taught and reinforced in positive ways and community should be celebrated.

Dr. Lauer also shared that their Tiered Support for Academics are structured as follows:

All students get: high quality, research-based, instruction for all.

Some students get: small group, targeted instruction with groups of approx. 4-12 students, targeting essential standards, and pre and post assessments.

Few students get: Increased intensity and / or frequency.

Behavior Support System is as follows:

All students: Classroom management system, Second Step curriculum-social emotional skills and We Teach Behavior.

Some students: Friendship groups, check-in / check-out (connects students with an adult on campus, a CICO facilitator, daily progress report) enabling student to focus on 2-3 goals that if improved, will increase quality of life. Data is tracked over time to determine if intervention worked.

Few students: 1-1 counseling

Dr. Lauer then shared some school activities that Mountain View is proud of. They have "Cougar Conversations", which are bi-monthly school-wide assemblies that serve 3 purposes:

- 1) to bring the entire student body together with their community,
- 2) to highlight student accomplishments
- 3) to give updated news and information

At the assemblies students perform the Pledge of Allegiance and sing the Mountain View song, share student accomplishments, Cougar Talent, the "Cougar Scoop" (news). They also have the MV Milers Club and the Cheer Team.

**4. Educational Specification– Dr. Lewis, Superintendent**

Dr. Lewis shared two videos showcasing educational specifications for future ready educational environments with the DAC representatives and discussed the recent field trip the Ed Specs committee took to Rio Del Sol School in Oxnard, LinkedIn, and the MOXI. Dr. Lewis explained options such as, furniture, technology, movable walls and writing surfaces. She then asked Reps to put what their "Needs, Wants, and Nice to haves" would be on post-it notes and these will be shared at the next meeting.
