**1. Welcome and Introductions**

Dr. Lewis opened the meeting at 8:49 am.

**2. Approval of the Minutes from September 19, 2019**

**3. Election of Chairperson and Vice Chairperson:** Dr. Lewis explained the duties of these roles and opened the discussion to the committee. Keely Gregorio motioned to nominate Alton Green as chairperson and Leslie Hogan seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Keely Gregorio nominated herself as Vice Chairperson. Leslie Hogan seconded. Vote was unanimous.

**4. Review of DAC Expectations and bylaws:** Dr. Lewis reviewed modified Article IV, Section 7., Secretary, of the Bylaws with the committee. Alton Green made a motion to approve the modified bylaws.

**5. School Presentation – Dr. Joanna Lauer, Principal**

Principal Lauer shared her presentation of Mountain View School and explained how she is using the model of “The Multiplier Effect” to provide a supportive environment for both staff and students. Mountain View School has 343 students, two classes per grade level, K – 6, three special education classrooms and provides art, music, PE, STEAM and garden. Dr. Lauer explained that they have exciting things going on at their school such as Cougar Conversations

which takes place every other Friday from 8:15 am – 8:40 am and The Milers Club which is every Friday from 7:45am – 8:15am. Both of these programs are open to all parents, students and staff.

Dr. Lauer explained the different systems of support at the school which include PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports) and Behavior Support Systems (Counseling, Friendship Groups, Check-in-Check-out, classroom management, curriculum and we-teach behavior).

The goal of Mountain View School is to increase positive behavior, in a positive way and to promote kindness, listening and following directions and staying on task. Similarly, the three core values are Respectful, Responsible and Inclusive.

**6. SBAC Presentation – Dr. Mary Kahn, Assistant Superintendent**

Dr. Kahn presented a general overview of the most recent district-wide student achievement results from the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) system. She showed the new, online system to the committee and walked them through how to navigate and view the results.

**7. Review Proposed DAC Schedule**

Dr. Lewis reviewed the 2019 - 2020 DAC schedule and discussed the upcoming topics.

**8. Announcements and Discussions**

Kyle Begley discussed the Lemon Run and how it was the 3<sup>rd</sup> biggest event in SB in the area this year. She appreciates all of the support from the participants, including district staff, Administrators and Principals.

Mary Kahn discussed the 3<sup>rd</sup> Dual Language Immersion Program (DLI) Task Force meeting and explained the process. She invited everyone to the next Family and Community Information Nights, which will take place on November 13<sup>th</sup> and December 18<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 – 6:30 pm at El Camino School.

Dr. Lewis discussed the anticipated PSPS (Public Safety Power Shutoff) process and how we are diligently preparing for the possibility of losing power at our school sites.
