**3. Special Education Presentation – Dr. Cherylin Lew, Assistant Superintendent, Pupil Services**

Dr. Cherylin Lew shared a presentation and data on the pupil services department including:

- Student enrollment
- Pupil Services Department staff
- Areas of Oversight
- Programs for students with IEPs
- Modified Curriculum
- In-Person Instruction for intensive programs began on October 22, 2020
- Mild-Moderate programs in-person instruction is set to begin on November 30, 2020

**4. COVID-19/School Re-Opening – Dr. Donna Lewis, Superintendent and Dr. Mary Kahn, Assistant Superintendent, Instructional Services**

Dr. Lewis talked about the following topics:

- Moving into the purple tier
- Survey to parents
- Waivers
- Different cohorts: AM/PM model versus hybrid 2/3 plan
- Employee testing

Dr. Mary Kahn shared a presentation that included talking points as follows:

- Purple Tier
- New restrictions on schools
- Parent and Staff Surveys

- Special Board Meeting: December 2<sup>nd</sup> to discuss purple tier and waivers
- Possible Options: (1) Programs all remote for now (2) 5- day modified schedule or (3) Half-cohort model (AM/PM or 2/3 hybrid)
- Campus preparation (indoor/outdoor learning spaces, staffing, sanitization, transportation, technology, bell schedules and screening and routines)
- Small Group Cohorts (special Education, essential car programs, high risk students, ASES Programs)

The committee then asked numerous questions about the proposed learning models, waivers, asynchronous work and in-person learning.
