# 4. COVID-19/Return to In-Person – Dr. Donna Lewis, Superintendent and Dr. Mary Kahn, Assistant Superintendent, Instructional Services

Dr. Lewis shared the Santa Barbara County Community Data Dashboard and talked about the case rates and what that means for the reopening of schools. She also spoke about the following topics:

- Prioritization of COVID-19 vaccinations
- Closing school's small cohort groups due to lack of staffing
- Employee exposure to COVID-19

Dr. Mary Kahn shared information about the small cohorts at each of the school sites.

#### 5. Social Justice/Addressing Racism – Dr. Donna Lewis

Dr. Mary Kahn spoke about the following topics:

- The Dual Language Immersion Program is currently enrolling for next year
- Support for our community and at each school site
- The task force has started the next pilot with Ally to Accomplice
- Individual teachers or teacher teams who are ready to use the resources should go ahead and use them. Mary will talk more about this in Leadership with the principals.
